There will be parking in the usual car parks.

The costume samples that have been distributed for children are around Year 4 size. We hope to distribute the rest of the costumes soon to you with the intention that they will all be useful on the day.

The formal activities will be over by about 11.30 and the fun will begin .... ice cream, face painting, music, clog dancing and ukulele workshops, stalls etc until 3pm.

After the Parade, all schools will be allowed to keep the costumes they receive in the hope that they will be reused for folk dancing / performance in the future.
